### Principal Hester's Message



Dear Families of Washington High School,

Spring means Student Led Conferences (SLC's) at WHS. To date, nearly 90% of our students have completed an SLC. Seven years ago, only 63% of our students completed their SLC. Our goal is for 100% of our students to complete their SLC every year. The quality of the presentations continues to improve each year. Thank you to our students for taking this responsibility seriously, to our staff for advising students through the process, and to WHS Career Center Secretary, Sheryl Moore, for helping by organizing the whole process. Finally, thank you so much to our families for making this a priority and supporting your student at their SLC.

Senior Prom is coming up on May 5<sup>th</sup> and is a time of celebration for our seniors. Please talk with your student about making good choices on prom night. We don't want to see anything stand in the way of them participating in our graduation ceremony, and we certainly want prom night to be a safe and enjoyable event for our students to remember.

Speaking of graduation, it is quickly approaching. Continuing to improve on-time graduation rate is a critical school improvement goal for us, so please do not hesitate to contact your student's counselor if you have any questions or concerns regarding the graduation status of your student. Our on-time graduation rate over the past five years is 85%, and our five-year extended graduation rate is over 90% for the past two years. We expect the Class of 2018 to exceed those percentages. Graduation will take place at the Puyallup Fairgrounds at 1:30 on June 9<sup>th</sup>. Please see inside this newsletter for more detailed information about graduation.

Patriot students and staff have experienced many great accomplishments since our last newsletter. Our Patriot Powderpuff Team, under the leadership of their coaches Jeff Scott and Kelly Miles, took on the FP Cardinals. The Patriots came away with a thrilling victory on a last second field goal. Speaking of the Daffodil Parade, I am looking forward to watching our award-winning cheer, band, and AFJROTC programs performing in the parade on Saturday, April 7<sup>th</sup>. We have nearly 100 students in our band program, over 100 cadets in our AFJROTC program, and 240 students out for athletics this spring.

Finally, it is with a great deal of emotion that I am announcing this year will be my last as principal at WHS. I recently accepted an offer to move into the district office as our Executive Director of Human Resources and Business Services. I am excited to continue serving our district in a new way, but very sad to be leaving a place that I love. Eleven years ago, we were labeled as a "dropout factory", and now we are recognized as one of the Top 50 High Schools in Washington State! Eleven years ago, only 36% of our students said they were proud of our school. Now, that number consistently exceeds 90%. The turnaround in student achievement, and school pride at WHS would not have been possible without the efforts of our amazing staff, and the wonderful students that you send us every day. As principal, and a graduate of WHS myself, I am so proud of what we have accomplished through our collective efforts. I can confidently say that I will never have a more rewarding job in my life. I am also confident that all the pieces are in place for us to continue, and even accelerate, the positive momentum. Thank you all for supporting me in this position that I have loved for the past eleven years. Patriot and Parkland Pride!!!

Please help us support your student(s) by monitoring their grades on-line, asking to see their completed homework, and contacting teachers. I look forward to seeing you at a school event soon. Go PATS!

## PIERCE COUNTY SKILL CENTER (PCSC) 2018 SUMMER SCHOOL

PCSC Summer school classes will be held at Keithley Middle School starting June 25-August 2 (*no school July 4th*). Skills Center classes will have 2 sessions: June 25-July 13 and July 16-August 2. Times are 7:45 am -2:45 pm. Students can get a .5 credit for each class taken. Skills Center classes are free. Health will be offered in our district through PCSC Skills Center summer classes. It's suggested 8<sup>th</sup> graders take a health class during the summer to make room for other course offering at the high school.

## FPSD CREDIT RETRIEVAL SUMMER SCHOOL

The Franklin Pierce School District will be conducting a credit retrieval opportunity this summer with APEX using FPSD teachers June 25–August 2 (*no school July 4th*) at Keithley Middle School for a \$30 fee. **This summer school program only serves those students who have previously failed the course.** You will get more detailed information on hours and registration procedures soon.

### QUESTIONS YOU MAY HAVE FOR JOSTENS...

#### **When is the latest we can place an order?**

Technically, June 30<sup>th</sup>. However, we suggest if you want to order just a cap and gown unit, by June 1<sup>st</sup>. The deadline to order all other graduation products is May 1st.

#### **When do we have to make a final payment?**

The final payment for orders placed in the fall is March 1, 2018 to avoid a potential late fee assessed to the order.

#### **When will our cap and gown along with graduation products delivery occur?**

All orders that were made prior to the December deadline date will be delivered during the lunches on Monday, April 2, 2018. Caps and gowns ordered after the December deadline and prior to March 25, 2018 will also try to be delivered on that date.

#### **Can I use or borrow a cap and gown from a previous year?**

Yes, as long as the cap and gown is from Jostens. You will still need to order a class stole and classic souvenir tassel by calling Jostens at 1-800-Jostens.

#### **Can I purchase a cap/gown/tassel/stole unit at graduation?**

Yes; the cost is \$60 and must be exact change. We do not carry cash on that day.

#### **Can I purchase a stole and tassel at graduation?**

Yes; the cost is \$30 and must be exact change. We do not carry cash on that day.
